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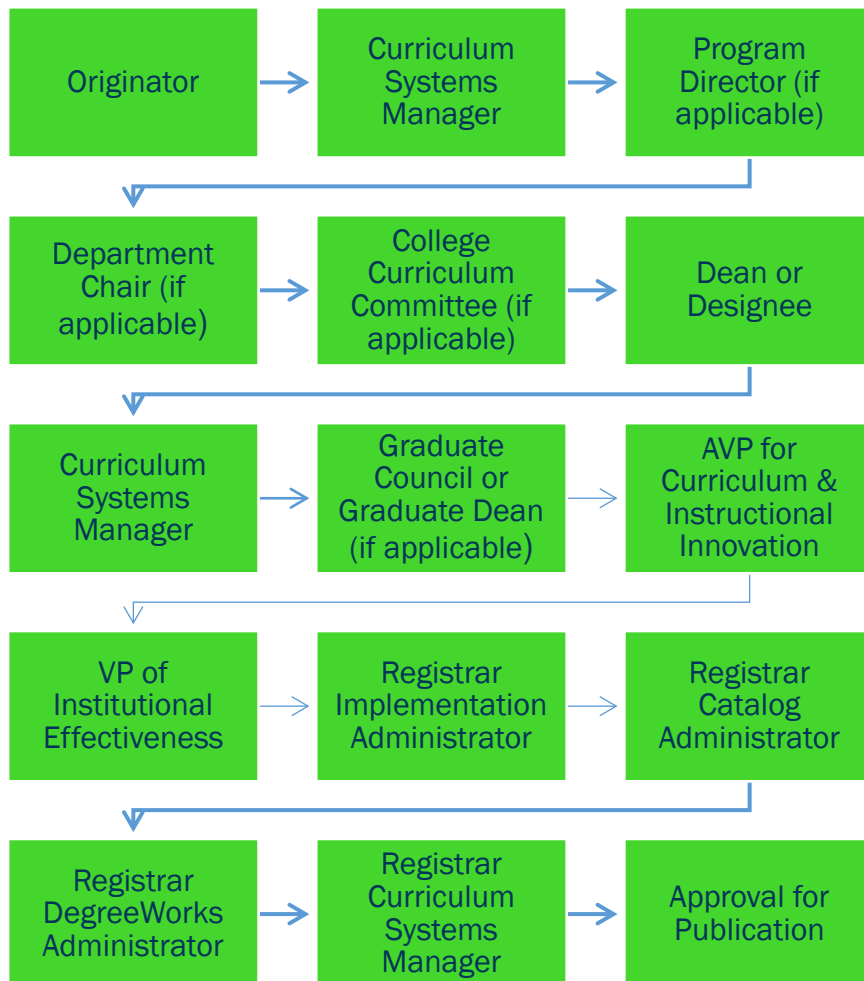
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CURRICULOG: NEW ACADEMIC PROGRAM INSTRUCTIONS

PROCESS

The New Academic Program is used to request approval for a program that is not currently listed in the Augusta University catalog. New academic programs must first be approved via the Academic Forecast before they can be added to Curriculog. New academic programs must be approved by the Board of Regents to be included on the Degrees and Majors Authorized at Augusta University. Upon Board of Regents approval, the program will be added to the Augusta University catalog.

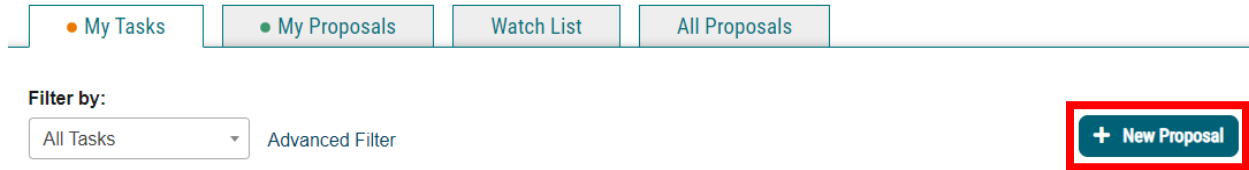

CREATING THE PROPOSAL

1. Login to Curriculog using your AU Net ID and password.

2. Select “New Proposal” from the task menu.

3. Hover over the proposal titled New Academic Program and click the blue check mark in order to begin.



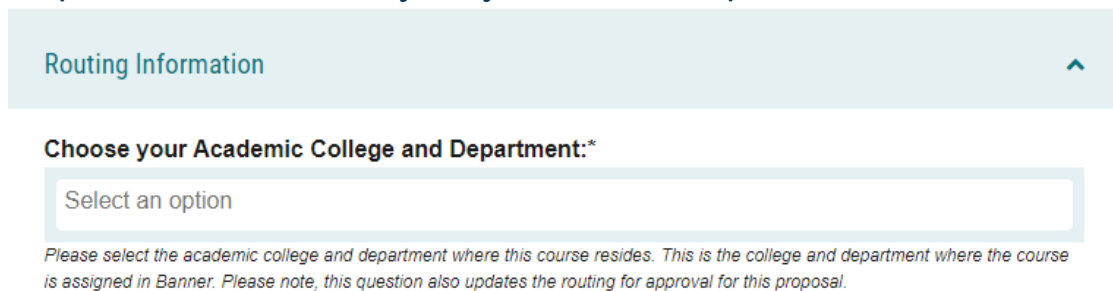

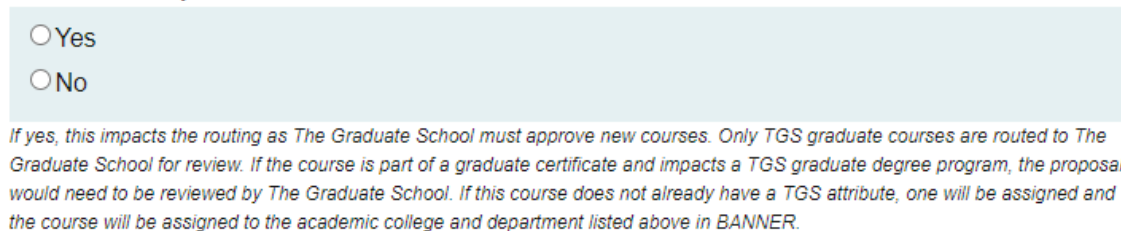

6. Select the appropriate option regarding Program Director.

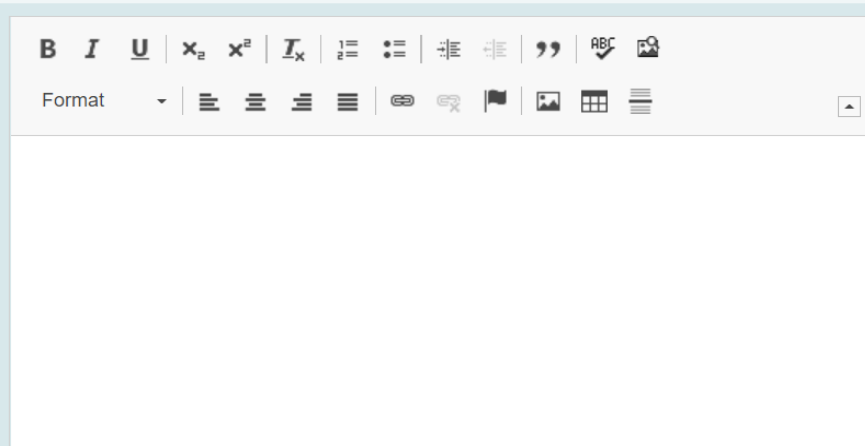

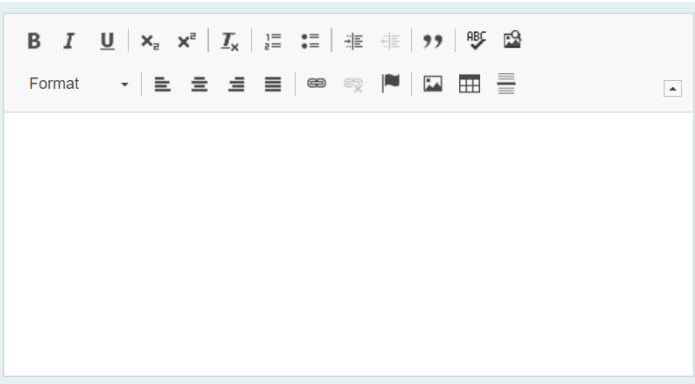
-Please note this should be a resource email account for the department, not a personal email.

26. Enter Admission Requirements.

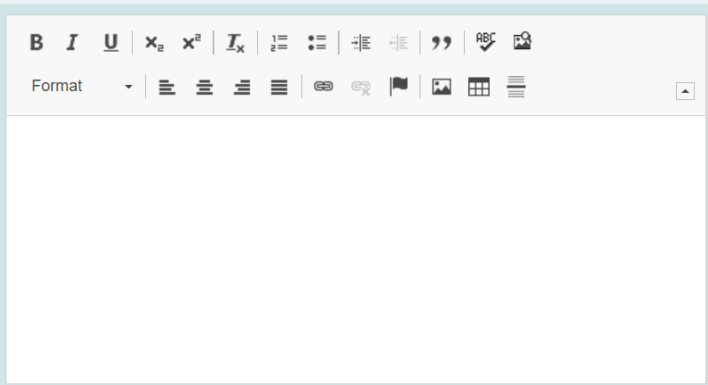
Admissions Requirements*

27. Enter Program Accreditation Information

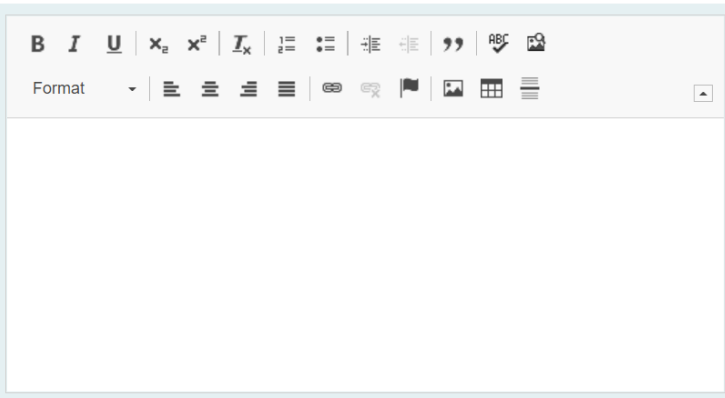

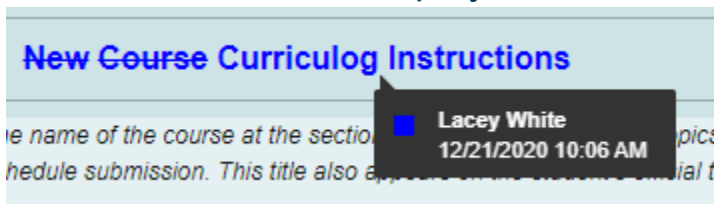
HELPFUL TIPS

USER TRACKING

1. Track proposal updates by turning on User Tracking – Show Current with Markup.
