Advisement**

- Concentrate on one or two programs and follow up in depth.
Commit an hour each week to focus on each of your target majors. Visit the academic department offering that major and talk with an advisor for the program.
- Investigate the career paths associated with your target majors.
Visit Career Services and learned more about your employment options with your target majors. Inquire about internships or volunteer opportunities in the field. Check for emerging careers that may complement or offer alternative paths.
- Match your fit with each target. If it is a good, then move forward, but if not, go back and try another.
Interview several professionals in your target fields to learn the ups and downs of the work. Ask about the skill sets needed to succeed. Assess what you have and what you might need to develop.
- Reflect on what you have learned.
Meet with your advisor to discuss the information that you have gathered and to plan your next steps.
