

Election Timeline for College-level AU Senate Senator(s), Committee Representatives & the Election of Committee Chairs

1. Election Timeline announced by Governance Committee at January Senate meeting.
2. Each college develops a list of open positions for the new academic year 2017-2018 and submits it to Senate Secretary at or prior to February 6th Senate Meeting.
3. Each college announces the open positions and solicits nominees.
4. Each college finalizes the nomination list and submits it to the Senate Secretary by the March 6th Senate meeting. All open positions must have a minimum of one nominee.
5. Voting on Senator(s) & Committee representatives begins at each college March 7.
6. Election results announced & names of the elected sent to Senate Secretary by March 28.
7. Committees meet to welcome new representatives & elect 2017-18 Chair. Name of committee chair sent to University Senate by the end of April.
8. Senate Secretary provides progress report. Are all colleges on track?
9. New senators and committee representatives welcomed at Final Senate meeting on May 1st.
