THE GRADUATE SCHOOL DISTINGUISHED RESEARCH AWARD

The Graduate School Distinguished Research Award is presented annually to a member of the graduate faculty who has brought recognition and honor to Augusta University for the quality and quantity of his/her research. The criteria by which the nominee will be judged may include, **but are not limited to,** those listed below. A letter of nomination/support must be submitted with this nomination form. A CV will be requested from the nominee by The Graduate School.

Criteria:

- 1. Number of publications in referred journals, with particular emphasis on the publications within the past 5 years.
- 2. Percentage of those publications in which the faculty member was the senior author (first or last author and typically the corresponding author).
- 3. Quality of publications as judged by the quality of journals and numbers of citations.
- 4. Involvement in training young scientists at the graduate and postgraduate level.
- 5. Mentoring of and/or collaboration with other faculty.
- 6. Reputation in the field as judged by:
 - a. Number of review articles and where the articles appeared.
 - b. Chairing of regional, national, and international symposia in area(s) of expertise.
 - c. Service on grant review panels for national or governmental agencies.
 - d. Success of trainees in obtaining desirable postgraduate or professional positions.
 - e. Service on editorial boards.
- 7. Continuity and sources of grant support.
