An international applicant is a prospective student who is neither a U.S. citizen, U.S. national nor permanent resident of the United States and will require a non-immigrant (F Academic Student or J Exchange Visitor) visa for study in the United States.

International applicants must document their ability to meet all estimated educational and living expenses for the first year of their intended study before Augusta University can issue a Certificate of Eligibility for either the F Academic Student (Form I-20) or the J Exchange Visitor (Form DS 2019) per U.S. Department of Homeland Security and U.S. Department of State regulations. Although you are required to provide documentation for only the first full year of study, funding must be available for your entire course of study from your personal or sponsored funding sources. International students are NOT eligible for student financial aid and U.S. federal regulations severely restrict international student employment. Students who have not been offered and accepted part-time on-campus employment should not expect to subsidize their studies by earning income in the United States.

Applicants are encouraged to secure at least two original sets of supporting documents. One set should be forwarded to support your application to Augusta University, Summerville Campus, and the other used when applying for the visa at the U.S. Embassy or Consulate. All original official financial documentation must be in English, on letterhead or with seal, with original signature(s), and show the exact amount of money available in U.S. dollars.

In addition to the supporting documents, the applicant, parents and/or sponsors must complete, sign and submit the Augusta University *Certificate of Finances* form.
