- Provide students and the community with information regarding Augusta University programs
- Serve as encouraging role models and advocates of higher education
- Participate in special events including commencement ceremonies.

- Successful completion of at least twelve (12) credit hours prior to program enrollment
- Currently enrolled at Augusta University as an undergraduate student
- Cumulative GPA of 2.5 or higher
- Commitment of two (2) consecutive semesters
- Ability to commit to a minimum of 30 hours of service per semester including campus tours, training, and other campus events
- Availability for some evening and/or weekend activities
- Excellent verbal communication skills
