Access your username and student account.

Upon acceptance to Augusta University, please follow these directions: augusta.edu/its/account.php. Should you have any trouble accessing your account, please contact the IT help desk at 706-721-4000.

Register for Duo.

Account security is very important to Augusta University – so we use Duo two-factor authentication for multiple systems. Learn more about Duo and register for your account here: augusta.edu/duo.

Access your student email.

Log in to your Augusta University email at email.augusta.edu. AU email is the university's official form of communication, so expect updates regarding orientation, registration, billing, and course information in your AU inbox.

Log in to POUNCE.

POUNCE is Augusta University's student information portal. It includes information about registration, grades, financial aid, your student file, and more. Access POUNCE here: pounce.augusta.edu.

Check out university housing.

If you'd like to live on campus, visit augusta.edu/housing for more information.

Manage your financial aid.

Don't forget to fill out the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). By filing your FAFSA, you will be considered for need-based aid. Submit immunization documentation.

Submit verification of lawful presence.

The Board of Regents of the University System of Georgia requires all applicants to provide Augusta University with specific documentation verifying their lawful presence in the United States. For a list of acceptable documentation, visit augusta.edu/admissions/lawful-verification.



Confirm your tuition classification.

Please refer to your official acceptance letter for your tuition classification. If you're classified as out-of-state and wish to receive in-state tuition, you must complete a Petition for In-State Tuition Classification along with the required documentation. Arrange accommodations, if applicable.

Augusta University is happy to accommodate students with disabilities. If you have a disability or require special services, please contact the Office of Testing and Disability Services at 706-737-1469 or visit augusta.edu/tds.



Manage your student health insurance.

All students on AU's campus must have health insurance, and will be charged a student health insurance premium each semester. However, if you already have insurance that meets the campus requirement, you may forgo the fee by completing a waiver. Register for classes.

During the registration period, your department will email you the course reference numbers you'll need to register for classes. Don't forget to check your AU email for that information. For more details, visit the Registrar's Office website at augusta.edu/registrar.



Remember your JagCard.

Your JagCard is your official Augusta University ID, and can be obtained after registering for classes. The JagCard Office is located in Augusta University's Annex II building at 524 15th Street. For more information, visit augusta.edu/jagcard or email jagcard@augusta.edu.



Register for parking.
