- Two letters of recommendation are required. When applying, you must submit the names and email addresses of two individuals who can evaluate your academic strengths and abilities, past employment experience(s), or healthcare experience(s). Please note: Reference forms will be sent electronically to your selected individuals once your application has been received. Please be sure to allow enough time for reference forms to be sent AND returned. Applications submitted the last week of the application deadline may not allow enough time for this process.
