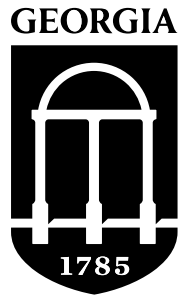

Announcing Poster Presentation awards to top scoring abstracts in the following categories:

Eligibility

- Graduate Students working on a Cancer related Project at AU or UGA
- Post Doctoral Fellows working on a Cancer related Project at AU or UGA
- Residents and Fellows working on a Cancer related Project at AU or UGA
- Tenure or Research track assistant professors at AU or UGA.

Required Proposal Content (*please download and use application template*)

A. Submission Form

1. Presenter names, degree, title, institution, department/unit, contact information (email, phone)
2. Title of Poster
3. Names and affiliations of all authors on the poster.
4. Name and affiliation of Principal Investigator.

B. Abstract(*all documents should be provided in standard NIH format, 0.5" margins, Arial 12 font*)

1. Project Summary/Specific Aims page. *1-page limit*. Organized as follows:
 - a. Proposed research Aim and hypothesis
 - b. Significance
 - c. Approach
 - d. Results and Conclusions
