

Anthony Holland has over nine years of experience as a Career Advisor, having served at both Paine College and Georgia Regents University. As Director of Career Services at Paine College (1998 to 2005), Mr. Holland developed a comprehensive Career Center for the college. He created and designed the Michael L. Thurmond Career Library, created and conducted new workshops for students and increased the number of students using the Career Center by 86% within his first three years.



Mr. Holland also served as Retention Coordinator for the College (1993-1998). As Retention Coordinator, he assisted the college in identifying factors impacting retention. He developed an early warning system for identifying at risk students, made the recommendation for a Retention Task Force, and planned and coordinated retention workshops for college staff to attend.

Mr. Holland also served as Project Administrator for the National Youth Sports Program (2000 to 2005) which was hosted on the campus of Paine College. As Project Administrator, Mr. Holland took a program that was on probation and brought it back into compliance with 90 federal guidelines. As a result of his work, the NYSP National Office selected him to serve as State Coordinator (2003-2005) for eight other colleges and universities hosting the program within the state.

After Pastoring full-time for 5 years (2005 to 2010), Mr. Holland returned to higher education in January 2011 as a Career Advisor at Augusta State University for the following majors: Chemistry, Physics, Pre-Engineering, Mathematics, Psychology, Sociology, Social Work, Criminal Justice, Political Science and Masters of Public Administration. As Career Advisor, Anthony works closely with the Career Center staff to meet the career planning needs of GRU students and recent graduates. In addition, Mr. Holland also works closely with academic departments for student programming, with local employers to increase student and recent graduate job opportunities and with graduate school representatives for students interested in attending Graduate School.

Moreover, Mr. Holland is also certified through the organization Partnership for Public Service as an Advisor for students and recent graduates who are interested in internship and full time job opportunities with the Federal Government. What is more, Mr. Holland serves as the Campus Coordinator for the Workforce Recruitment Program (WRP) for students and recent graduates with disabilities. In addition to serving as a local Pastor for over 17 years, Mr. Holland recently retired as a Chaplain Major from the United States Air Force Reserves, Charleston AFB, SC.
