## PURPOSE AND OBJECTIVES

## COURSE CO-DIRECTORS



**Jeril R. Cooper, III, DMD**, Professor of General Dentistry at the Augusta University, earned his dental degree from MCG. He maintained a full-time general dentistry practice for 30 years before joining Augusta University, where he has an active faculty practice in addition to providing clinical supervision in the Department of General Dentistry and is a member of the Augusta University Esthetic team. He is a member of the Pierre Fauchard Academy, Hinman Society, a Fellow of the Academy of General Dentistry and received Augusta University's 2008 Judson C. Hickey Award.



**Jacob K. Stern, DMD, M.Sc.**, is a Diplomate of the American Board of Periodontology, and the International Congress of Oral Implantologists. Currently, he is an Associate Professor, in Periodontics at the Dental College of Georgia (DCG), Augusta University (AU) where he served as program director for the advanced education in Periodontics. Dr. Stern completed his graduate training in Periodontics and a post graduate implant fellowship at the University of Pennsylvania, School of Dental Medicine. Dr. Stern has numerous publications in professional journals, and has contributed to important texts in his field. He has lectured on periodontics and implant dentistry before dental societies in the United States and abroad. In addition to his faculty practice, Dr. Stern serves as a consultant for the Ronald Goldstein Esthetic Implant Center at AU and for the VA Medical Center, Augusta, Ga.

## COURSE FACULTY



**Brock J. Pumphrey, DMD**, is a Diplomate of the American Board of Periodontology and is the owner of a private practice in Midtown, Atlanta. Dr. Pumphrey was born and raised in Atlanta, Georgia. He obtained a degree in Exercise Science from Florida State University, and received his Doctor of Dental Medicine from The Medical College of Georgia. He remained at MCG for additional training and completed his residency in Periodontics. Dr. Pumphrey has been published in numerous professional journals and has become a leader in the community for Interdisciplinary Treatment Planning, Implant Therapy, Mucogingival Management and Dental Esthetics. He is a current member of American Academy of Periodontology, Academy of Osseointegration, Hinman Dental Society, Georgia Dental Association, and the Spear Institute. Within the Spear Institute, he enjoys leading two study groups focused on interdisciplinary treatment planning.



**Jeril R. Cooper, IV, DMD**, is a graduate of Carson-Newman University, Medical College of Georgia School of Dentistry, and MCG Department of Orthodontics. He maintains a multiple location orthodontic practice in the Chattanooga, TN area along with two partners. Dr. Cooper is a Diplomate of the American Board of Orthodontics and Past President of the Georgia Orthodontists Foundation as well as a member of many leading dental and orthodontic organizations.



**Albert S. Chinappi, Jr., DDS, MS, ABO**, a graduate from Temple University Dental School, received a Master Degree in Orthodontics from Fairleigh Dickinson University and went on to obtain his specialty board certification from the American Board of Orthodontics. He managed an active practice in Marlton, New Jersey, treating both children and adults, especially adults with TMD issues. Dr. Chinappi served on the staff of the University of Pennsylvania Dental School as an Associate Clinical Professor in the Graduate Division, Department of Periodontics from 1997-2008. He has become a leader in the field of functional orthodontics and its application to the growth and development of children as well as its application to adult patients with head and jaw pain. In addition to lecturing extensively to various dental, pediatric and chiropractic groups, his particular interest in facial growth and development and the unity of form and function led Dr. Chinappi to write a series of articles which have been published in the Journal of Manipulative and Physiological Therapeutics and Inside Dentistry.
