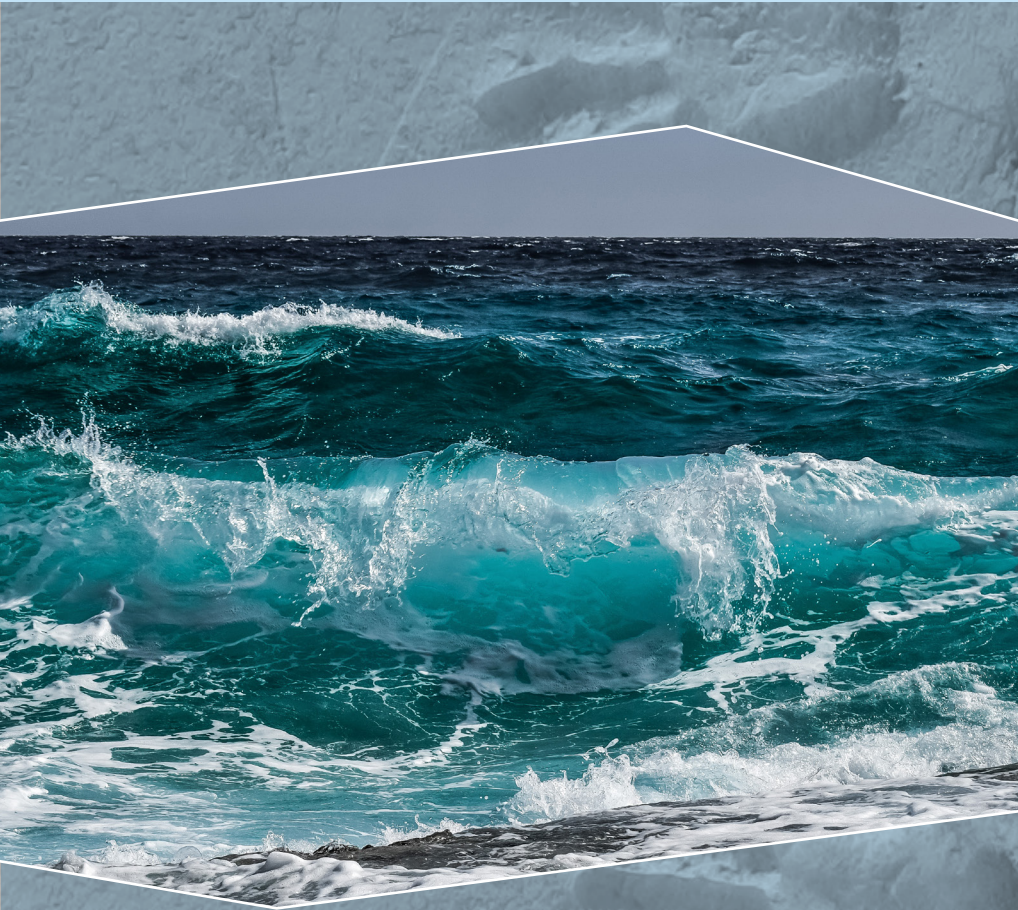

She then completed her certificate in pediatric dentistry and her master of dental science at the Ohio State University in Columbus, Ohio, in 2007.

Dr. Townsend serves on the editorial board of *Pediatric Dentistry* and is an editor of the textbook *Pediatric Dentistry, 6th Edition*. She is the Coordinating Editor of *Practical Reviews in Pediatric Dentistry* and has authored multiple articles and textbook chapters primarily focusing on pain control and behavior guidance for pediatric patients. She holds positions in the American Academy of Pediatric Dentistry and American Board of Pediatric Dentistry.

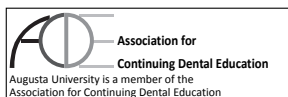
