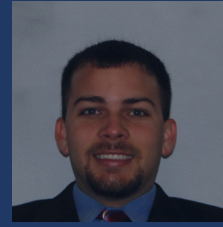


Todd Burgbacher, DO

Dr. Burgbacher graduated from the University of Florida with Bachelors of Health Sciences and received his Doctor of Osteopathy from Nova Southeastern University College of Osteopathic Medicine in 2009. Dr. Burgbacher received his training in Emergency Medicine at Medical College of Georgia. Dr. Burgbacher received further training in EMS while attending University of Texas Health Science Center San Antonio EMS Fellowship, where he also received hands-on experience in disaster response with the Southwest Texas Regional Advisory Council's Mobile Medical Unit (STRAC MMU) during the West Texas fertilizer plant explosion. He served as the only on-scene emergency medicine physician in the MMU field hospital. Dr. Burgbacher has been instrumental in starting Augusta University's (AU) Physician Response Vehicle, which is the only on-scene EMS physician vehicle in the state of Georgia. Dr. Burgbacher serves as Assistant Program Director for AU's EMS Fellowship and Assistant Professor of Emergency Medicine. He is Co-Medical Director of AU's paramedic program. He also serves as medical director of Aiken County EMS and assistant medical director of Gold Cross EMS.
