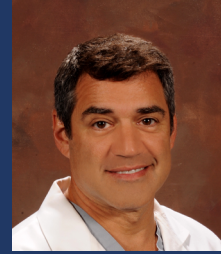


Michael Caudell, MD, FACEP, FAWN

Dr. Caudell completed his medical degree in 1993 and an Emergency Medicine residency in 1997, both at the Medical College of Georgia. Dr. Caudell is a Professor of Emergency Medicine and the Medical Director for Wilderness Medicine and Survival Medicine within the Center of Operational Medicine at MCG. He is also the Director of the Wilderness Medicine Fellowship at MCG. Dr. Caudell is one of the founders of MedWAR (Medical Wilderness Adventure Race) and serves as the Executive Director for the Southeast Race. He is also the Immediate Past-Chair of ACEP's Wilderness Medicine Section, Past -Chair of the Wilderness Medical Society Education Committee, a Fellow of the Academy of Wilderness Medicine (FAWM) and serves on the Board of Directors for the Wilderness Medical Society, the Appalachian Center for Wilderness Medicine and North American Educational Adventure Racing. He is a faculty member for the Advanced Wilderness Life Support (AWLS) course, and he is a Wilderness First Aid instructor. Dr. Caudell has earned the Diploma in Mountain Medicine (DiMM), as well as certification in Swiftwater Rescue and Advanced Open Water Diving.
