What are the ACGME Institutional Requirements for Wellness

Per ACGME Institutional Requirements, The Sponsoring Institution (i.e., MCG) must oversee its ACGME-accredited programs' fulfillment of responsibility to address well-being of residents/fellows and faculty members, consistent with the Common and specialty-/subspecialtyspecific Program Requirements, addressing areas of non-compliance in a timely manner (1). The Sponsoring Institution, in partnership with its ACGME accredited programs, must educate faculty members and residents/fellows in identification of the symptoms of burnout, depression, and substance abuse, including means to assist those who experience these conditions. This responsibility includes educating residents/fellows and faculty members in how to recognize those symptoms in themselves, and how to seek appropriate care (2). The Sponsoring Institution, in partnership with its ACGME accredited programs, must encourage residents/fellows and faculty members to alert their program director, DIO, or other designated personnel or programs when they are concerned that another resident/fellow or faculty member may be displaying signs of burnout, depression, substance abuse, suicidal ideation, or potential for violence; provide access to appropriate tools for self-screening; and, provide access to confidential, affordable mental health assessment, counseling, and treatment, including access to urgent and emergent care 24 hours a day, seven days a week (3). The Sponsoring Institution must ensure a healthy and safe clinical and educational environment that provides for access to food during clinical and educational assignments (4); sleep/rest facilities that are safe, quiet, clean, and private, and that must be available and accessible for residents/fellows, with proximity appropriate for safe patient care (5); safe transportation options for residents/fellows who may be too fatigued to safely return home on their own (6); clean and private facilities for lactation with proximity appropriate for safe patient care, and clean and safe refrigeration resources for the storage of breast milk (7); safety and security measures appropriate to the clinical learning environment site (8); and, accommodations for residents/fellows with disabilities, consistent with the Sponsoring Institution's policy
