

## GEORGIA REGENTS UNIVERSITY HOUSESTAFF MALPRACTICE INSURANCE INFORMATION SHEET July 1, 2014 - June 30, 2015

Physicians in residency training programs at the Georgia Regents University are insured for professional liability by the Department of Administrative Services (DOAS). This insurance covers all activities within the scope and course of your GRU residency program, at any location. Please note that moonlighting and other activities, which are outside of the scope and course of your GRU program, are not covered. The DOAS policies have limits of \$1,000,000 per person and \$3,000,000 per occurrence. Your insurance will continue to cover claims that relate to events that occurred during your residency or fellowship here, even after you leave GRU.

The Georgia Regents University pays for this insurance. Please note that your coverage is governed by the terms and conditions of the policies themselves, and that this document is merely a summary provided for your reference.
