For clarity, these are the four Non N-95 masks that AUMC regularly stocks. We may have additional masks secondary to outside donations related to COVID-19. Non N-95 masks are required in high risk areas. Optional in low risk areas.

Visitors will be required to wear a surgical or cone mask while in the hospital.

N-95 RESPIRATOR MASKS

For clarity, N-95 respirator masks are designated for specific patients on Airborne Isolation or Emerging Pathogens Precautions.

Required for aerosol-generating procedures and treatments for COVID-19 Positive patients or Patients Under Investigation (PUI).

Halyard Brand N-95 Respirator (duckbill with elastic straps) Warning: Please note the Halyard N-95 duckbill respirator has elastic straps and should not be confused with the Halyard non N-95 duckbill mask with ties.	Store in the brown paper bag during your shift per the instructions. Halyard brand N-95 respirators may not be reprocessed. <u>DISCARD THIS MASK AT THE END OF YOUR SHIFT.</u>
