GAE knows that it is important that future teachers must meet the requirements to obtain certification to teach, which includes earning a passing score on the Georgia Assessment for Certification of Educators (GACE). For the last 20 years, GAE has offered in-person workshops to help members prepare for the all-important GACE tests. I am writing today to inform you that GAE will continue to offer these workshops in an online streaming format via ZOOM.

No other educational organization in Georgia offers the GACE workshop. The workshop uses the Moodle learning management system to provide access to practice tests based on the objectives for each test. There are also links to study material to help participants refresh memories of previous content learning. Both the Program Admission and the Program Content workshops (Early Childhood, Middle Grades, Special Ed, and some secondary subjects) are offered.

Although this is a FREE members-only workshop, non-members may join gae.org to obtain access to ALL the benefits provided to our members. Student members may join for under \$20 a year!
