Students who are NOT employed will be required to attend a seminar conducted by Augusta University Career Services. It will be held on Wednesday, October 7 from 5:00 – 7:00. UH 224. This workshop will cover resume development, interviewing, and career fair preparation.

Attendance will be verified by seminar instructors through sign in sheets. **Make sure you sign in for each seminar. If you arrive late or leave early, you will be required to complete an additional assignment.**

If the placement school requires any additional seminars, candidates are required to attend those meetings as well. The school seminars will be in addition to the required Augusta University seminars.
