


BEGINNING COLLEGE SURVEY OF STUDENT ENGAGEMENT



985 students who registered for summer orientations in 2018 were invited to take the Beginning College Survey of Student Engagement. 444 (45%) responded.



High School Habits


- 43%**
spent 1 to 5 hours per week preparing for class
- 44%**
did not work while in high school
- 31%**
spent 1 to 5 hours per week participating in co-curricular activities
- 34%**
spent 1 to 5 hours per week relaxing and socializing
- 70%**
received mostly A's during their last year of high school

VS.

College Expectations

- 25%**
expect to spend 11 to 15 hours per week preparing for class
- 78%**
expect to work their 1st year of college
- 31%**
expect to spend 6 to 10 hours per week participating in co-curricular activities
- 38%**
expect to spend 6 to 10 hours per week relaxing and socializing
- 69%**
expect to receive mostly A's during their first year of college
