WHAT WILL OUR GRADUATES BE DOING 6 MONTHS AFTER GRADUATION?



63% will be employed part-time or full-time

- **87%** of those graduates will be working in Georgia
- **66%** of those graduates will be in a position that requires a college degree and is related to their field of study
- **28%** of those graduates will be making between \$50,000 - \$74,999
- **51%** of those graduates will be starting a new job



3% are already enrolled in a program to continue their education

- **42%** of those graduates will be continuing their education at Augusta University
- **58%** of those graduates will be pursuing their master's degree



25% will still be looking for a job



7% are planning to continue their education 6 months after graduation



1% will be serving in the US military

453 students who responded to the survey reported:

• **74%** would likely recommend Augusta University to an interested student

• **57%** of the 296 likelihood explanations were positive
