WHAT WILL OUR GRADUATES BE DOING 6 MONTHS AFTER GRADUATION?



53% will be employed part-time or full-time

- **42%** of those graduates will be working in Georgia
- **39%** of those graduates will be in a position that requires a college degree and is related to their field of study
- **18%** of those graduates will be making between \$50,000 - \$74,999
- **28%** of those graduates will be starting a new job



10% are already enrolled in a program to continue their education

- **5%** of those graduates will be continuing their education at Augusta University
- **4%** of those graduates will be pursuing their master's degree



30% will still be looking for a job



5% are planning to continue their education 6 months after graduation



1% will be serving in the US military

653 students who responded to the survey reported:

• **73%** would likely recommend Augusta University to an interested student

• **72%** of the 365 likelihood explanations were positive
