# Ethics, Transparency and Trust in Pharma and the Role of the Good Pharma Scorecard

Jennifer E. Miller, PhD, is an Assistant Professor in NYU School of Medicine, President of Bioethics International, and Creator of the Good Pharma Scorecard- an index that ranks new drugs and pharmaceutical companies on their ethics and public health performance to help recognize good practices in companies, improve trustworthiness, and incentivize change where needed. Prior to joining NYU, Dr. Miller was based at Duke University and Harvard University.

Dr. Miller serves on The World Economic Forum, NYU's Pharmacy and Therapeutics Committee, Stem Cell Research Oversight board, and J&J-NYU Compassionate-Use Advisory Committee (monitor). Previously, she served on the CDC Task Force for Pediatric Emergency Mass Critical Care, the AMA Advanced Disaster Life Support Education Consortium, as a consultant to the UN Economic and Social Council, and on the PCORI-NIH Collaboratory.

Dr. Miller's work explores the ethics and governance of how medicines, biologics, and health technologies are researched, developed, marketed, priced, and made accessible to patients.
