The Master of Public Health (MPH) degree is a multidisciplinary professional degree emphasizing the practical aspects of public health. The program is designed to give both clinicians and nonclinical professionals – with undergraduate preparation in any field – knowledge and skills in core public health competencies to promote the health of populations in today's rapidly changing environment.

Professionals with an MPH degree are leaders in evidence-based public health practice including patient-centered care and community health. Our MPH program prepares professionals with the research skills to critically evaluate public health literature and put those results into practice.

Augusta University offers an innovative, collaborative MPH program with concentrations in health management, health informatics, environmental health, and social and behavioral sciences. The MPH program is accredited by the Council on Education in Public Health (CEPH).

Health Management

Health Informatics
