ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- ❖ Associate of Science in Nursing from an accredited program and an accredited college or university. A Diploma in Nursing may be considered.
- ❖ Minimum undergraduate GPA of 2.8 on a 4.0 scale (cumulative) and a minimum overall graduate GPA of 2.80 on a 4.0 scale *if applicable*.
 - Applicants who earned less than a “C” in two or more courses in their Nursing program will not be considered for admission.
- ❖ GRE or MAT graduate entrance exam taken within the **last 5 years**
 - Minimum GRE score requirement is 290 (combined Verbal and Quantitative sections)
 - Minimum MAT score requirement is 400
- ❖ Official transcripts of all post-secondary education
- ❖ An official, professional course-by-course evaluation (based on official transcripts and documents) is required for all foreign educational transcripts and documents from one of the following three credentials evaluation services: Josef Silny & Associates, Inc., World Education Services (WES), Educational Credential Evaluators, Inc. (ECE). Official transcript evaluations based on unofficial transcript, documents or copies will not fulfill this requirement.
- ❖ Proof of unrestricted Georgia RN license is required prior to enrollment
- ❖ 1000 hours of clinical practice in the last four years OR have graduated from an accredited Nursing program within the last four years
- ❖ Current BCLS/CPR certification
- ❖ Current resume or curriculum vitae
- ❖ Three letters of recommendation- Email addresses for three references will be entered on NursingCAS application
- ❖ If applicable, TOEFL score of 55 paper-based, 213 computer-based or 79 internet-based For more information, visit <http://www.augusta.edu/admissions/international.php>
- ❖ Personal interview
- ❖ Essay addressing experience and CNL role (included on application)
- ❖ Completion of required USG core curriculum with a C or better <http://www.augusta.edu/nursing/undergraduate/index.php> to include:
 - Human Anatomy and Physiology (8 credits); included in Area F
 - Microbiology (3 credits); included in Area F
 - Chemistry with lab (4 credits)
 - Statistics (3 credits)
 - General Psychology (3 credits)
 - Human Growth and Development- Lifespan (3 credits); included in AREA F
