Summer courses should follow the Pamplin Guidelines for Summer Scheduling, unless an exception has been granted by the Dean (www.augusta.edu/pamplin/documents/pamplinsummerguidelines.pdf).

Pay for summer courses varies depending on the number of AU students enrolled, as described below.

Summer pay also varies depending on the number of credit hours of instruction. **The pay rates specified below reflect a typical 3-credit-hour course.** A 2-credit-hour course would be paid at 66% of this rate, and a 1-credit-hour course would be paid at 33% of this rate.

Courses:

- A flat rate of **\$5000** will be paid to faculty teaching undergraduate summer courses that have **15 or more students enrolled**.
- Courses with **10-14 students** may be offered at a **pro-rated pay** (\$5000 minus \$333 for each student below 15) per the table below.

- Courses with **9 or fewer students will be cancelled**. Chairs may petition the Dean for exceptions. If an exception is granted, the course will be offered at a **pro-rated pay** per the table below.

Study Abroad:

- Faculty teaching Study Abroad courses (3 credit hours) will be paid a **flat rate of \$5000** for an enrollment of **10 or more AU students**.
- Study Abroad courses with **9 or fewer AU students will be prorated** (\$5000 minus \$500 for each student below 10) per the table below.
