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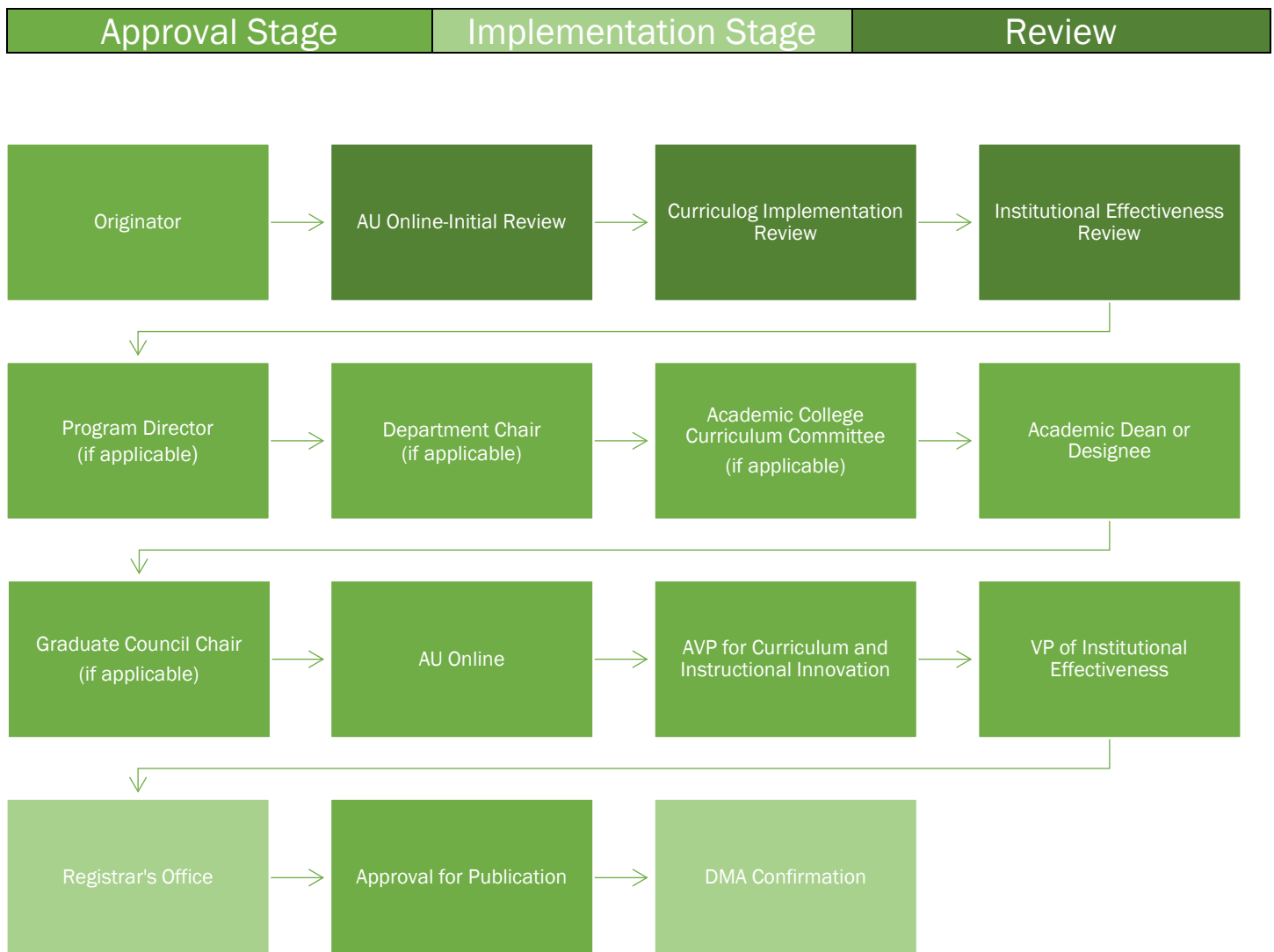

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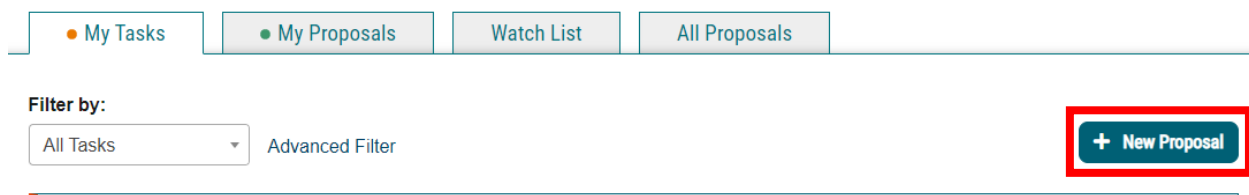

CREATING THE PROPOSAL

1. Login to Curriculog using your AU Net ID and password.

2. Select “New Proposal” from the task menu.

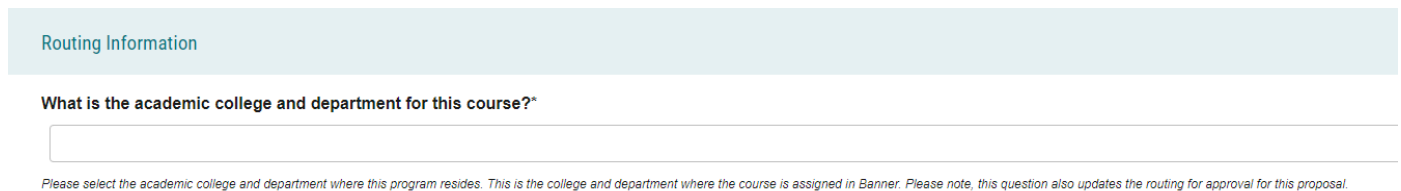

CER0: Fewer than 30 semester credit hours (less than one year).

CER1: From 30 to 59 semester credit hours (at least one year, but less than two).

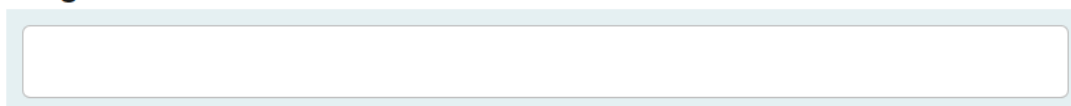

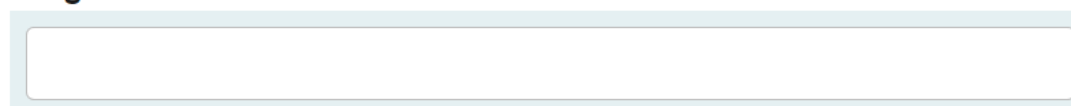

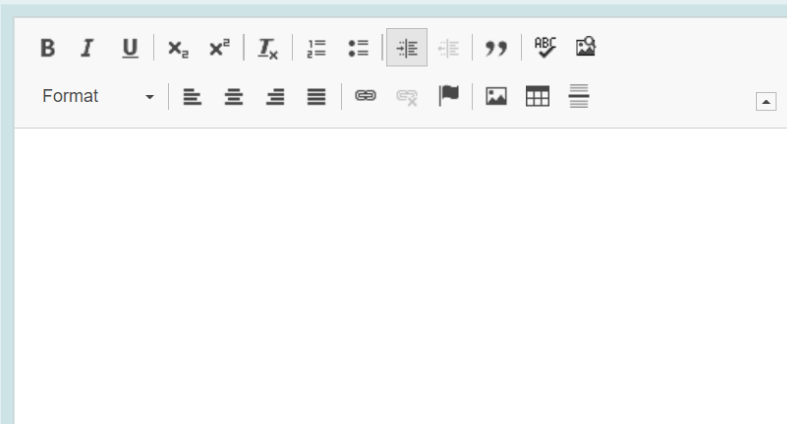
