Applications are now being accepted for the Dr. & Mrs. J. Gray Dinwiddie, Jr. Chemistry Scholarship.

If you would like to word-process your application, email nbourne@gru.edu and you will receive a reply with the form attached. You are urged to pursue recommendations ASAP. Applications should be sent/delivered to the Department of Chemistry and Physics, Georgia Regents University so as to arrive no later than Friday, March 28, 2014.

For consideration for this scholarship, a minimum G.P.A. of 3.00 is required. An award is made for the academic year, subject to review each semester. A cumulative G.P.A. of 3.00 must be maintained and a minimum credit of 12 semester hours must be earned each semester. Additional criteria are as follows:

DINWIDDIE CHEMISTRY SCHOLARSHIP

To be eligible, applicants must be seeking graduation from Georgia Regents University as a professional Chemistry major, must have attained at least sophomore standing, and must have attended Georgia Regents for one full year. The scholarship will be awarded on the basis of scholastic ability and an exhibited interest in the liberal and fine arts at Georgia Regents.
