Dear Professional:

In order for a student to receive course and testing accommodations based on Autistic Disorder, this office must receive the following documentation:

Specific documentation guidelines for Autism Spectrum include the following:

- a) Diagnosis and corresponding code from the most recent DSM.
- b) Assessment of the following diagnostic criteria is required and evaluation results must be included:
 - a. Developmental history that includes evidence of Autism Spectrum symptoms in childhood.
 - b. Documentation of current qualitative impairment in social interaction.
 - c. Documentation of current qualitative impairment in communication.
 - d. Documentation of current restricted, repetitive, and stereotyped patterns of behavior, interests, and activities.
 - e. Assessment of broad cognitive ability and language function using standardized assessment measures with age-appropriate norms.
- c) Documentation must include the names, signatures, titles, and license numbers of the appropriate evaluators, as well as the dates of testing and contact information. Evaluators must be licensed professionals whose training and licensure status is consistent with expertise in the disability for which they provide documentation.
